

Arboretum Gold Trail



- #1 – Start at Cady Mall SW corner of MU. Southern Live Oak
- #2 – Directly south of #1, a planter of 3 San Jose Hesper Palms



- #3 – Carob tree
- Walk south on Cady.



- #4 – Silk Oak
- Turn west at Ag.



#5 – Continue west, Chinese Pistache, **no sign**



#6 – Italian Cypress



#7 - Silk Floss



#8 – Desert Spoon.

Turn left, then right to the south side of Student Services.
Plants #8-17 in desert planter



#9 – Medusa Acacia, sign is hard to find at the base of tree
in the center of dangerous to walk through cactus garden.

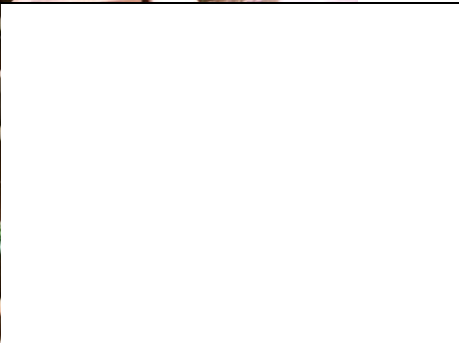
#25 – Sago Palm **Sign needs to be moved from potted sago to large specimen sago**

Walk out the north side of courtyard and proceed right.

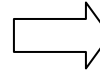


#31 – Japanese Pittosporum

Continue north the Lang & Lit building



#56 – Senegal Date Palm

Turn right to the north side of Lang & Lit

Look to your left to see the pomegranate

No sign & duplicate tree is at location #41



#59 – Cork Oak **No trail sign & not a good idea on Alumni lawn. There's a nice cork oak on Tyler Mall**



#60 – Texas Plume

Continue walking south between Lang & Lit & Old Main



? There's two behind planter

#61 – Arizona Cypress **No sign No tree?**

Turn right onto Tyler Mall



#62 – Giant Bamboo **No sign**



#63 – Nagami Kumquat **Sign is blank and is too low in planter to be noticed**

Turn left onto Cady Mall and kumquats are in a raised planter in front of Social Science



#64 – Canary Island Pine

Tree is to your right in center lawn

#67 – Texas Ebony

Sign is in wrong location in the raised planter with the Ironwood tree.
