2009-2010 SCHEDULE OF CHARGES AND DEADLINES

(Schedule of Charges and Deadlines is subject to change)

PAYMENT DEADLINES

Table with 2 columns: Housing Living and Dining Confirmation Payment, Amount. Amount is \$125.

Table with 3 columns: Payment Plan 1 – 1 Payment per Semester, Fall Semester Deadline, Spring Semester Deadline.

Table with 4 columns: Payment Plan 2 – 3 Payments per Semester, Fall Semester Deadlines, Spring Semester Deadlines.

Table with 2 columns: Winter Break – Only 1 Payment for the Semester is Available, Winter Semester Deadline.

Late Charge Assessment: Charges must be paid by the date due. University billings not paid by the date due are subject to late charges beginning at 30 days past due.

Collection Agencies: Delinquent accounts will be referred to outside collection agencies and will be reported to national credit bureaus.

NOTICE OF NON-ATTENDANCE, REFUNDS, AND RELEASE PROVISIONS OF ROOM ASSIGNMENT

All Notices of Non-Attendance must be submitted in writing directly to University Housing.

First time freshman admitted to ASU will be refunded \$100 of the Confirmation payment if the student submits a Notice of Non-Attendance prior to May 1, 2009 (Fall) or December 1, 2009 (Spring Only Admits).

If student has not been approved for an exemption of the housing expectation prior to hall opening and is enrolled at ASU, the student will be held financially responsible for all room and board charges.

After initial check-in to housing assignment (requires an approved written License Agreement Release*)

- Room charges are re-calculated based on the daily room rate from the date the residence halls open... A License Agreement Release processing fee is assessed for all approved License Agreement Releases... Damage charges and/or an improper check-out fee may be assessed if applicable... The semester Support Services and Payment Plan and Residential College fees are non-refundable after official hall check-in... Meal plan charges are re-calculated based on usage of M&G and/or meal blocks.

*Valid reasons for License Agreement release are: graduation, withdrawal / transfer from ASU, academic internship sponsored by ASU and military duty activation. See your hall staff for details.
