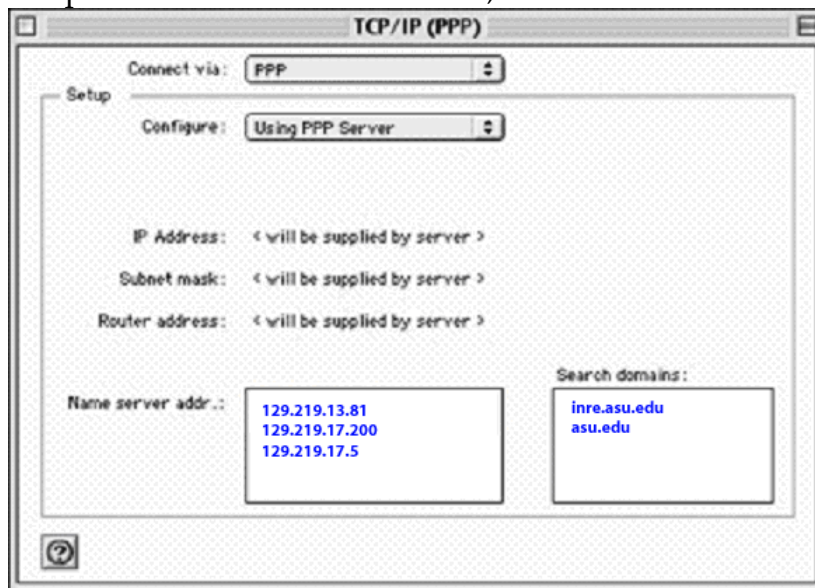

Introductions

Apple Macintosh OS classic (8.5 – 9) PPP is easy and straight forward. Follow the following Instructions to set up your Mac to connect to ASU.

1. Open the **TCP/IP Control Panel**, under **Control Panels** in the **Apple Menu**.



2. Select **PPP** from the **Connect via:** menu. Select **Using PPP Server** from the **Configure:** menu

3. Enter the **IP addresses** of ASU servers.

Configure the Remote Access Control Panel

1. Open the **Remote Access Control Panel**, under **Control Panels** in the **Apple Menu**.
2. Select **Registered User**.
3. In the field next to **Name**, enter your ASURITE ID.

4. Leave the **Password** field blank, which will cause OT/PPP to ask you to enter your password each time you connect. (If you wish NOT to be asked to enter your password each time you connect, enter your password in the **Password** field and check the **Save password** box).
