#### Campus Safety Tips:

- Always use the 'buddy system' when walking outside after dark.
- Utilize ASU Safety Escort Service

#### <u>Download the Free ASU LiveSafe app</u> <u>at LiveSafe.asu.edu</u>

- Send ASU Police real-time, anonymous tips that include chat, pictures, audio and video.
- Activate SafeWalk and chat live with your designated emergency contacts (friends or family) during your trip as they view your step-by-step progress on a map.
   Deactivate SafeWalk after your trip.
- Alert personal emergency contacts in times of distress with a link to your accurate GPS location.
- Enable the anonymous reporting option, or include your user information to relay more accurate location facts.

### Crime Alert

During the past week, there have been two incidents on the Tempe Campus where female students have been accosted by strangers.

On 1/29/17 at approx. 4 a.m., a White Male subject (mid 20's, 5'9", medium build, dirty blonde hair, facial hair, glasses, wearing a light colored hoodie) approached a student in the area of McAllister Ave. and University Dr. and grabbed her buttocks and then fled.

On 2/2/17 at approx. 12:45 p.m., a White Male subject (med build, dark "buzzed" haircut, pronounced gap between teeth, wearing a white t-shirt) followed a student into the Tyler St Parking Structure and exposed his genitals and then fled.
