ATP NOTES

1. The ACC230 and ACC240 sequence must be taken at one institution, either MCCCD or ASU.
2. If ACC111 or ACC211 are taken, the student is likely to exceed 120 hours for graduation.
3. COM100, or COM100AA/COM100AB/COM100AC will be accepted in lieu of COM230. COM 230 is recommended.
4. Transferable as lower division credit only. Students must still meet the 51 hour requirement for upper division hours.
5. MCCCD GBS 220 transfers in lieu of MAT 211 for Business majors.
6. If JAS225 has already been taken, the College of Business will accept it in lieu of the QBA221 requirement. QBA 221 will become ECN 221 effective Spring 2007.
7. Select an [HU] course that concurrently fulfills [C] or [H] requirements.
