ATP NOTES

1. The ACC230 and ACC240 sequence must be taken at one institution, either MCCCD or ASU.
2. Transferable as lower division credit only. Students must still meet the 51 hour requirement for upper division hours.
3. If JAS225 has already been taken, the College of Business will accept it in lieu of the QBA221 requirement. QBA 221 will become ECN 221 effective Spring 2007.
4. MCCCD GBS 220 transfers in lieu of MAT 211 for Business majors.
5. Select 3 hour course that can satisfy two of the awareness areas [C], [G], or [H] to avoid accrual of 65 hours.
6. Select 3 hour course that can satisfy both the [HU] and either [C], [G], or [H] to avoid accrual of 65 hours.
7. Select 3 hour course that can satisfy both the [SB] and either [C], [G], or [H] to avoid accrual of 65 hours.
