ATP NOTES

1. The ACC230 and ACC240 sequence must be taken at one institution, either MCCCD or ASU.
2. If ACC111 or ACC211 are taken, the student is likely to exceed 120 hours for graduation.
3. Management majors must take COM225 or COM259, with COM225 being preferred.
4. MCCCD's COM230 may satisfy ASU [L] requirements if designated as [L] in the CEG for the semester in which the course was taken.
5. Transferable as lower division credit only. Students must still meet the 51 hour requirement for upper division hours.
6. If JAS225 has already been taken, the College of Business will accept it in lieu of the QBA221 requirement. QBA 221 will become ECN 221 effective Spring 2007.
7. MCCCD GBS 220 transfers in lieu of MAT 211 for Business majors.
8. Select 3 hour course that can satisfy both the [HU] and either [C], [G], or [H] to avoid accrual of 65 hours.
