<sup>1</sup> The ACC230 and ACC240 sequence must be taken at one institution, either MCCCD or ASU.

<sup>2</sup> Minimum Grade of B- required for Accountancy Majors

<sup>3</sup> If ACC111 or ACC211 are taken, the student is likely to exceed 120 hours for graduation and may also exceed maximum transfer hours.

<sup>4</sup> COM100, or COM100AA/COM100AB/COM100AC will be accepted in lieu of COM230 for Accounting ATP students. COM 230 is recommended

<sup>5</sup> MCCCD's COM230 may satisfy ASU [L] requirements if designated as [L] in the CEG for the semester in which the course was taken.

<sup>6</sup> Transferable as lower division credit only. Students must still meet the 51 hour requirement for upper division hours.

<sup>7</sup> If MAT 220 or MAT 230 are taken, the student is likely to exceed 120 hours for graduation, and may also exceed maximum transfer hours.

<sup>8</sup> If JAS225 has already been taken, the College of Business will accept it in lieu of the ECN221 requirement
