## ATP NOTES

<sup>1</sup> The ACC230 and ACC240 sequence must be taken at one institution, either MCCCD or ASU.

<sup>2</sup> MCCCD's COM230 may satisfy ASU [L] requirements if designated as [L] in the CEG for the semester in which the course was taken.

<sup>3</sup> Transferable as lower division credit only. Students must still meet the 51 hour requirement for upper division hours.

<sup>4</sup> If JAS225 has already been taken, the College of Business will accept it in lieu of the ECN221 requirement

<sup>5</sup> If MAT 220 or MAT 230 are taken, the student is likely to exceed 120 hours for graduation, and may also exceed maximum transfer hours.

<sup>6</sup> To avoid the accrual of more than 64 hours, select a 3 hour course that can satisfy both the [HU] and either [C], [G], or [H]; and a 3 hour course can satisfy both the [SB] and either [C], [G], or [H]; and *at least* one course that can satisfy **two** of the awareness areas [C], [G], or [H]
