¹ The ACC230 and ACC240 sequence must be taken at one institution, either MCCCD or ASU.

² Minimum Grade of B required for Finance Majors.

³ If ACC111 or ACC211 are taken, the student is likely to exceed 120 hours for graduation, and may also exceed maximum transfer hours.

⁴ Management majors must take COM225 or COM259, with COM225 being preferred

⁵ MCCCD's COM230 may satisfy ASU [L] requirements if designated as [L] in the CEG for the semester in which the course was taken.

⁶ Transferable as lower division credit only. Students must still meet the 51 hour requirement for upper division hours.

⁷ If JAS225 has already been taken, the College of Business will accept it in lieu of the ECN221 requirement.

⁸ If MAT 220 or MAT 230 are taken, the student is likely to exceed 120 hours for graduation, and may also exceed maximum transfer hours.
