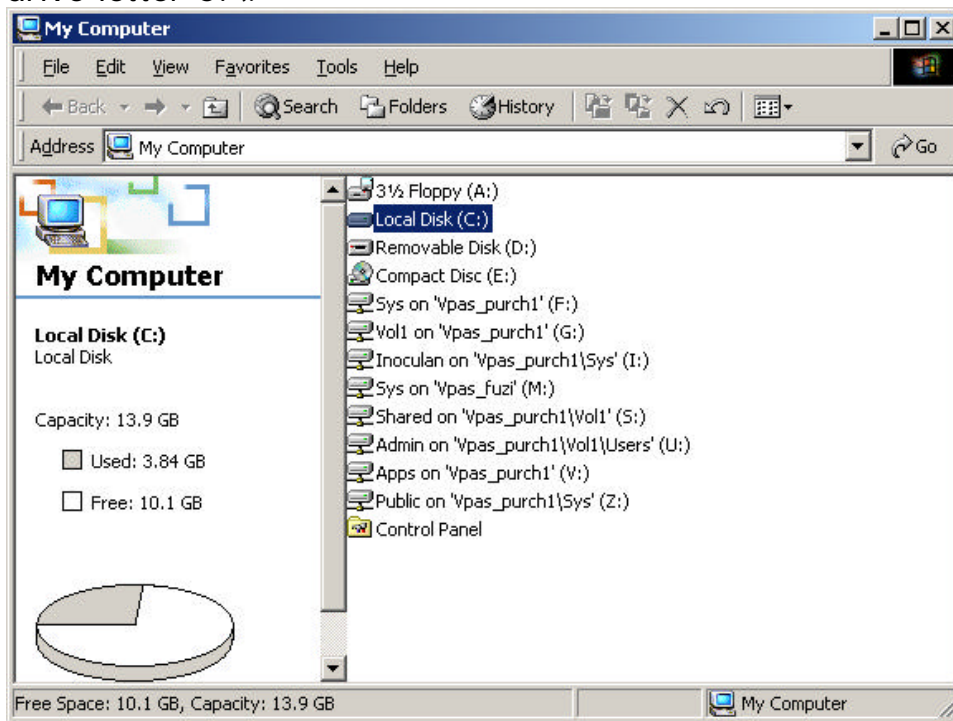


Installing The Property Control Application on Your Local PC

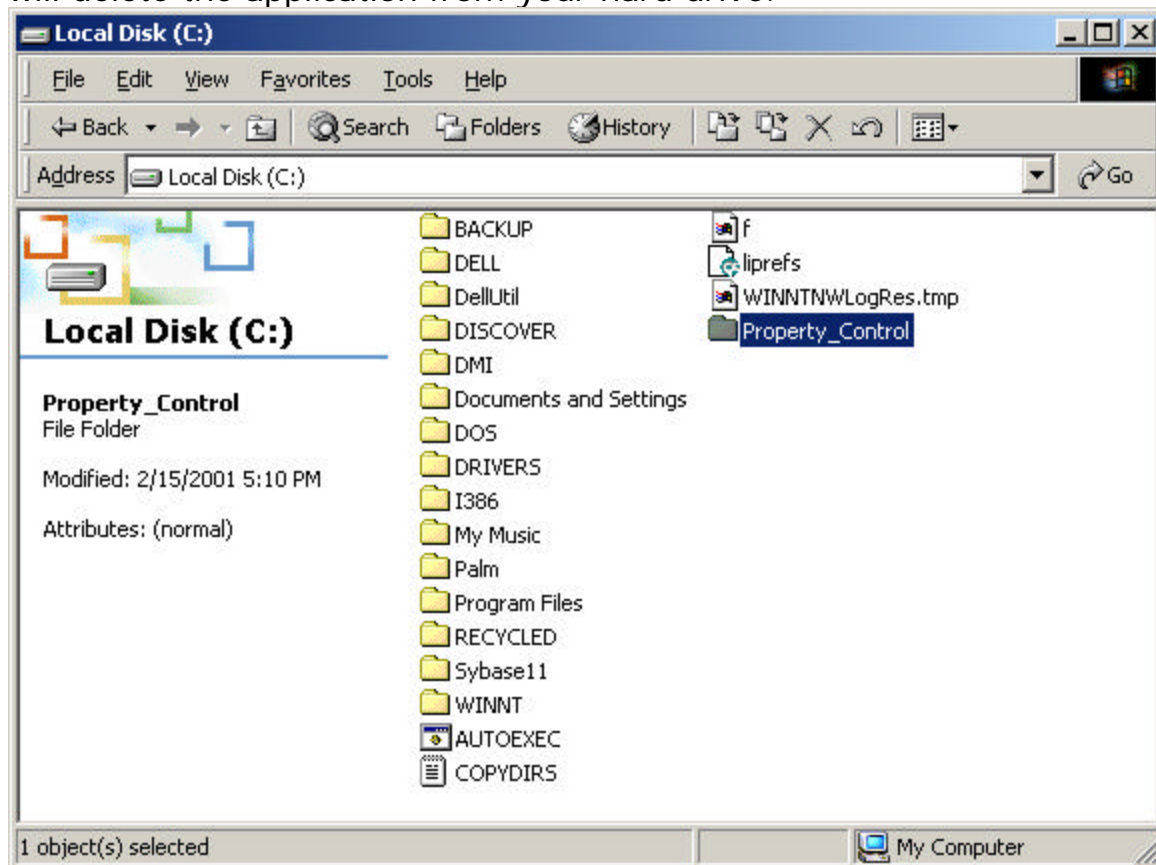
We have made a change for all users to run the application locally on their C: drive rather than to run the application off of a network server. This helps speed up performance and allows us to distribute the application easier.

READ ME FIRST: If this is your first time installing the application from the WEB, please be sure to start from Step 1. **If you are currently running the application from the server please proceed to Step 3.** If you have already installed this from the WEB before, you must uninstall the current Property Application. To do this click Start, Programs, Property and click Uninstall. Once this is done you may proceed to Step 4.

Step 1. Double click the My Computer icon and then double click the drive letter C:\.



Step 2. Locate the directory `property_control` and single click it to highlight/select it. Then press the delete key on your keyboard. This will delete the application from your hard drive.



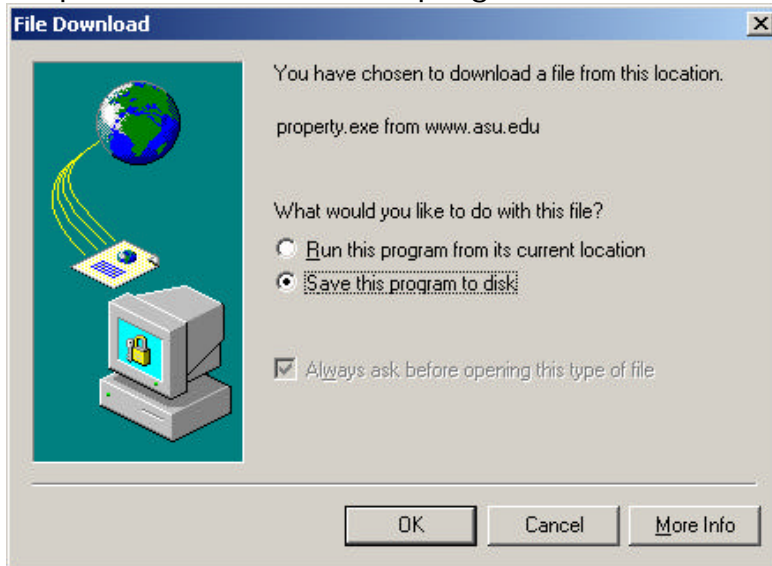
Step 3. Close the window and single click the Property Icon



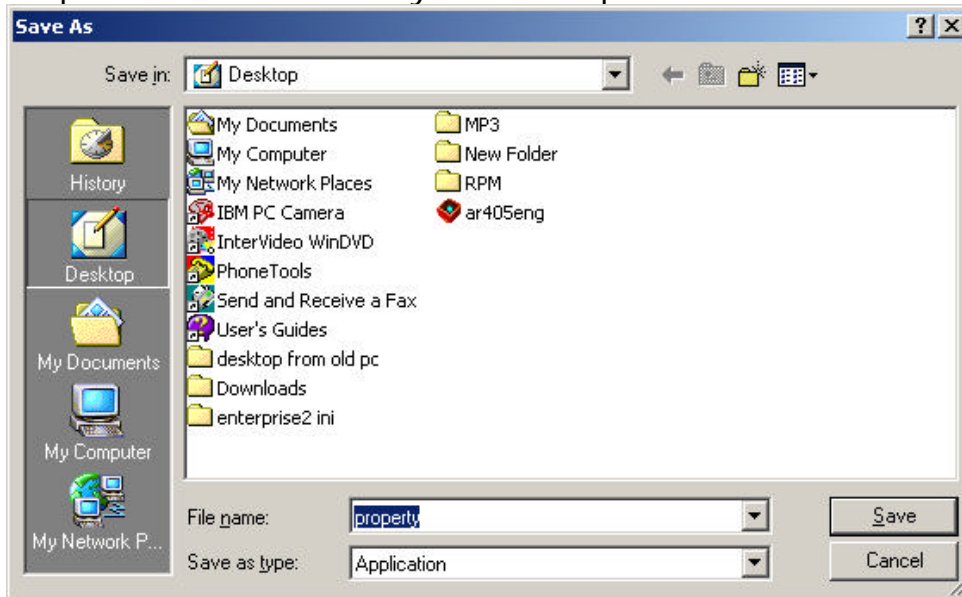
Property.lnk on your desktop and press the delete key on your keyboard. This will remove the shortcut to the old application.

Step 4. Click [here](#) to download the latest version of the application.

Step 5. Choose save this program to disk and click Ok.

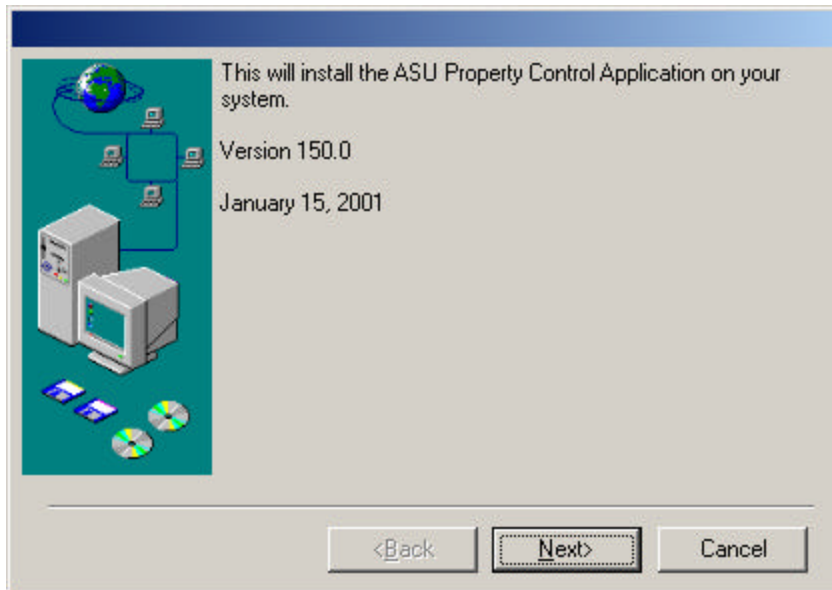


Step 6. Save the File to your desktop.

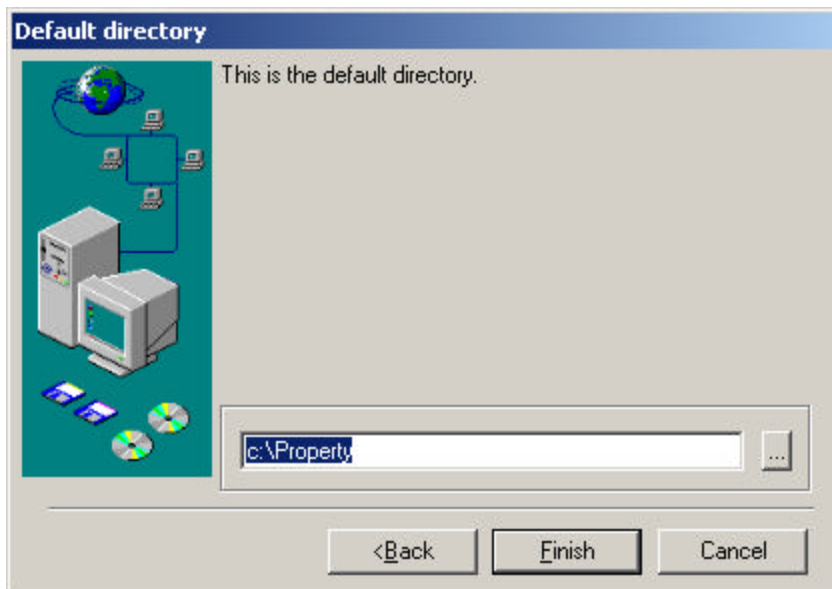


Step 7. Once the file has completely downloaded, you may close your browser.

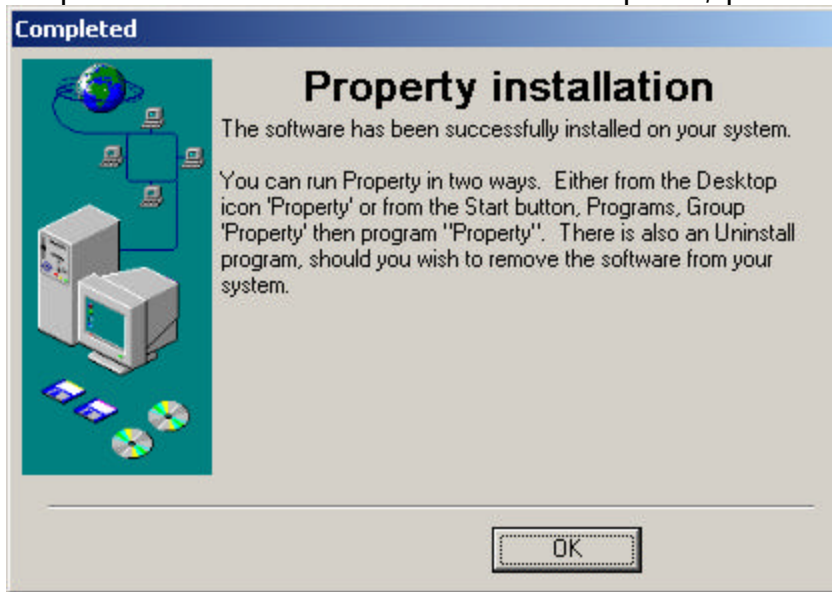
Step 8. Locate the file (property.exe) and double click on it to begin the installation. Press Next.



Step 9. Leave the default directory as C:\Property and click Finish.



Step 10. When the installation is complete, press Ok.



Step 11. You can now delete the icon from your desktop that looks



like this `Property.exe` . If the system requires a reboot, please reboot your



system, otherwise you can click on the Property icon `Property.lnk` to run the application.
