Residence hall safety tips:

- Always lock your doors even if you are just going down the hall or next door for a few minutes.
- If you see someone or something suspicious, call the ASU Police Department immediately to report it.
- Never leave external doors propped open. If you find a propped open door, close it.
- Always use the 'buddy system' when walking outside after dark.

- Send ASU Police real-time, anonymous tips that include chat, pictures, audio and video.
- Activate SafeWalk and chat live with your designated emergency contacts (friends or family) during your trip as they view your step-by-step progress on a map. Deactivate SafeWalk after your trip.
- Alert personal emergency contacts in times of distress with a link to your accurate GPS location.
- Enable the anonymous reporting option, or include your user information to relay more accurate location facts.

On December 3, 2017 at approximately 12:51 a.m., four suspects entered Hassayampa "B" wing second floor on the ASU Tempe campus and assaulted a victim with a small baseball bat. The four also robbed the victim with a gun.

Suspect's description:

- Four African-American Males
- Early 20s
- 5 foot 8 inches tall to 6 foot 2 inches tall, all with thin builds
- All wearing dark clothing to include large jackets. One wearing a black balaclava, one wearing a dark hoodie.
- One suspect has been identified as Orlando Higginbottom.
